

The Department of Companion Animal Clinical Studies at the University of Pretoria (South Africa), invites applications for a permanent faculty position in **Equine Internal Medicine**.

The successful applicant will join a team of 7 equine, 5 small animal surgeons, 14 small animal medicine, 4 anaesthetist, 3 clinical pathologist and 4 Diagnostic Imaging clinicians. From the total of 50 veterinarians in the Department, 19 are specialists of whom 12 hold European or American Diplomas in different specialties. The hospital case load is diverse and equipment is constantly being upgraded. The Faculty has a state-of-the-art Small& Large Animal Hospital, which includes 7 small animal surgery and 3 large animal surgery theaters. Equipment in the Diagnostic Imaging clinic includes a Siemens dual slice CT machine (including sliding gantry for horses), a MIE scintigraphy suite and a FUJI CR and PACS system. There are separate ultrasound machines (Prosound F75 and Sonoscape S8 and Aloka SSD 4000) in the large and small animal sections and X-ray equipment is of a high standard with new equine equipment installed. The small animal MRI is currently performed off-site. The Clinical Pathology Laboratory is accredited by the European College of Veterinary Clinical Pathology.

The Faculty of Veterinary Science (located at Onderstepoort) with the modern spacious hospital, is located on a beautiful campus on the outskirts in the northern part of Pretoria. Pretoria has a population of approximately 2 million, and is situated 70 km north of Johannesburg. Several game reserves are nearby, including the Kruger National park (400 km away), which gives plenty of options for outdoor activities and leisure.
