The School of Animal and Veterinary Science conducts teaching, research and clinical services at the Roseworthy Campus. The school is situated on a 1600 ha property that includes a working farm, a full service veterinary teaching hospital, animal holding facilities, and a range of general purpose and specialist teaching and research spaces and laboratories.

The School has excellent facilities developed for its veterinary program including an outstanding Companion Animal Health Centre and a Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory. The Equine Health and Performance Centre offers hospital-based services, in addition to the ambulatory service which has been operational for several years. A number of experienced and well qualified equine clinical academic staff are in place, including specialist internists, surgeons, theriogenologists, an equine sports medicine clinician and an ambulatory team providing general practice services.

We are seeking a Veterinarian who is eligible to register in South Australia to practice as an equine clinician in support of the specialist clinicians and first opinion practitioners in the equine hospital. The Intern will also assist in the training of undergraduate students through practical classes and clinical service delivery. The intern will work closely with members of the specialist team with both referral and first opinion cases such that this internship will provide an excellent opportunity for the development of strong equine clinical skills.

To be considered for this position you will be expected to demonstrate a strong interest in equine clinical practice through your undergraduate training and, preferably, through your post-graduate clinical work.

You should have:

- Qualification in Veterinary Science acceptable for registration in South Australia
- Some experience in equine clinical practice or, for new graduates, strong equine clinical skills.
- Strong interpersonal skills and demonstrated ability to work collaboratively as a member of teaching and research teams

This is a full-time, fixed term appointment for one year. The position will be available from February 2016. The role will include participation in an after-hours roster.
