Our caseload is rapidly growing and comprises mostly sport-, and pleasure horses, and a small number of racehorses.

Responsibilities include sharing the daytime medical service and emergency coverage during nights and week-ends, teaching to the students in equine rotation, as well as interns and residents. You must be comfortable with all aspects of emergencies.
