**The position**

A post is available for a veterinary internist holding DipECEIM or DipACVIM (or equivalent) to contribute to our internal medicine service while one of our Senior staff is on maternity leave. Our caseload consists of Thoroughbred, Sports and pleasure horses with a range of medical disorders, encompassing all aspects of critical care, sports medicine and general medicine. Medicine clinicians are primarily hospital-based but we also support our colleagues in ambulatory practice by providing specialist consultations on local farms and training yards. The successful applicant may also be expected to report haematology and blood biochemistry data and advise veterinarians using RosSDales Laboratories on case management. The hospital is very well equipped particularly in the areas of Diagnostic Imaging and Cardiology and we have excellent facilities for Neonatology in the Peter RosSDale Foal Unit and we will shortly open a new Medical Intensive Care unit (primarily for adults).

Our working week includes Saturday morning and the position will include evening and night work, particularly during the foaling season.
