Job description

As a Specialist in Equine Internal Medicine you'll:

- contribute to patient care and related teaching of students at various levels of their clinical rotations;
- participate in the evening, night and weekend (emergency) duties in Equine Internal Medicine;
- contribute to (applied) research in an area of equine internal medicine;
- contribute to the teaching of internal medicine in both the Bachelor and Master phases of the curriculum;
- update teaching material and write and mark exam questions under the guidance of a senior staff member.

Qualifications

- Diplomate of the ECEIM or the ACVIM (*Equine*);
- Extensive knowledge of the equine industry;
- Proven aptitude for clinical teaching or the willingness to develop this;
- Highly motivated, creative, enthusiastic, flexible and a team player;
- Fluent in Dutch and in English (spoken and written) or the willingness to learn basic Dutch within the period of the initial appointment.

Offer

A fulltime position (1,0 FTE – 40 hours/week) for one year with the possibility of extension upon satisfactory performance. The monthly gross salary is dependent on experience and will be in scale 10 of the Collective Agreement on Terms of the Dutch Universities (minimal € 2.501,- and maximal € 3.997 ,- gross per month). Secondary benefits based on the Collective Labour Agreement of the Dutch Universities are generous and include a good pension scheme, 41 days leave per year, flexible [employment conditions](#), partially payed parental leave, and a salary supplemented with a holiday bonus of 8% and an end-of-year bonus of 8.3%.
