This list is updated by the ECEIM Education and Credentials Committee annually. Please make sure you are using the latest copy of the list.

The following meetings are considered by the Education and Credentials Committee to have fulfilled our definition of an International Congress or Conference for the purposes of Diplomate re-evaluation. Please note that although we recognize that Diplomates may attend many other valuable meetings, only those listed below will be awarded the “international” points when your annual re-evaluation points are calculated. Veterinary, Medical and Scientific meetings that are not on this list, will be awarded “national” points.

- *Annual congresses of All American Specialty Colleges (ACVIM, ACVS, VECCS etc)*
- *Annual Conventions of American Association of Equine Practitioners*
- *British Equine Veterinary Association Annual Congress*
- *Congrès de médecine et chirurgie équine de Genève*
- *International Equine Colic Symposium*
- *International Conference of Equine Exercise Physiology*
- *World Equine Veterinary Association*
- *World Equine Airway Symposium*
- *Conference on Equine Sports Medicine and Science (CESMAS)*
- *The Voorjaarsdagen Congress*

To add a meeting to this list, two Diplomates must nominate the meeting and the meeting organisers must produce evidence that the programme is arranged by a Scientific Committee of more than three people and where the meeting is specifically linked to an association based in one country or region, the conference/congress organisers must send a letter of confirmation that >20% of the attendances come from other countries or regions. Copies of the scientific programmes for the last three meetings are submitted to the Education and Credentials Committee for review. This information should be submitted to the Chairman of the Education and Credentials Committee before 30<sup>th</sup> June each year.
