The equine clinic of Oniris, Nantes Atlantic College of Veterinary Medicine, Food Science and Engineering in France is opening a position for a resident in Equine Internal Medicine (standard ECEIM program), starting September 1st, 2023.

The Veterinary Teaching Hospital of Oniris is located on the outskirt of the city of Nantes in a beautiful landscape along the river Erdre. Nantes is an active city, rich of its history and touristic attractions and a 40-minute drive to the Atlantic Ocean. Our team is young and dynamic and is consisting of more than 20 equine veterinarians including 6 to 8 interns, 2 ECEIM residents, 2 ECVS residents, 1 ECVAA resident, 1 ECAR resident and 6 Diplomates (2 ECEIM, 2 ECVS, 1 ACVAA, and 1 ECAR). Our caselog is rapidly growing and is quite diverse, ranging from sports medicine to neonatal intensive care.

Prerequisites:

- The applicant must be a graduate from a veterinary school and must have an authorization to practice veterinary medicine in a European country.
- The applicant must have at least followed an internship program over a 12 months period. Alternatively, the applicant must have acquired a similar experience over a minimal length of 24 months in medicine and surgery in a clinic, which fulfils the criteria defined by the ECEIM guidelines.
- A good knowledge of English and French is mandatory.

Description of responsibilities:

- The resident will follow an ECEIM standard residency program of a minimal length of 3 years (156 weeks), including external rotations, professional presentations, international conferences attendance, and the realisation of a research project.
- The resident will perform its clinical services and research project within the equine internal medicine team of Oniris.
- The resident will be performing stand-by duty (emergencies service during night, weekend and holidays).
- The resident will be actively involved in academic education.
- Remunerations will be consistent with a full-time position for a junior veterinarian (More information available upon request).
