Kildare, Ireland. The successful applicant will share in-hospital internal medicine responsibilities with our current specialist, and join a team of two board-certified surgeons, eight ambulatory veterinarians, team of veterinary interns and veterinary nurses, and a laboratory technician, in addition to office/ administrative staff and grooms. The caseload is 90% Thoroughbred racehorse, with a strong neonatology component. The hospital includes two surgical suites, isolation stalls, several ultrasound machines, digital radiography, 1m and 3m videoendoscopy, nuclear scintigraphy, pharmacy, and a laboratory.
