The Vetsuisse Faculty, University of Bern, invites young, female scientists to apply for a research position as

**Assistant Professor in Veterinary Clinical Sciences, non-tenure track (4 years)**

Successful applicants are expected to develop a strong research program in veterinary clinical sciences, to supervise PhD, doctoral and master students, and to contribute to teaching. The position is supported by internal funding, but acquisition of external funding is expected.

Candidates must have a Board (European/American)-certified specialization in a clinical field, and a strong research profile. The application must include a CV, a publication list, a short documentation of ongoing and past research and clinical activities, of third party funding, of teaching and student supervision, as well as the names and contact information of three references. Importantly, the application must contain an outline of the planned research program and its relation to clinical sciences (maximum 2 pages). Applicants need to contact in beforehand the potential host institutes or research foci at the Vetsuisse Faculty Bern in order to clarify possible collaboration and support. The announced position is part of a program to attract female veterinarians for an academic career. As such, the position is open only for applications by women. The University of Bern is committed to support the compatibility of family and work.
