Ludwig-Maximilians University - Munich, The Equine Hospital, is seeking an ACVIM/ECEIM Diplomate (or eligible) for a full-time clinical instructor position (TVL scale - E14).

The Equine hospital of the LMU Munich is seeking an enthusiastic person in patient care, research and teaching.

The position will primarily involve equine medicine patient care with a diverse spectrum, supervision of interns and residents, as well as students and young DVM graduates research activities. We are a referral center providing high-end elective and emergency patient care. Our case load is diverse with respiratory, cardiology, gastro-intestinal, neurology, dermatology, fever of unknown origin as well exercise intolerance cases. Our research focuses on equine neurology/neuropathology and diagnostics, EHV-1 pathogenesis and epidemiology, endometrial inflammation and male (in)fertility.

The Equine Hospital is currently building a new state-of-the-art facility at the already existing large animal/production animal campus at Oberschleissheim in the Northwest of Munich. We will move into this facility by mid-2020. At this new site, our already existing ample range of diagnostic modalities (endoscopy, ultrasound, telemetry, EEG, EMG, tcMS) will include state-of-the-art CT and MRI. We are seeking a person that is either looking for an interim position for a minimum of 6 months to a year (minimum requirements: boards eligible ACVIM/ECEIM), or to fill a long-term position in our team. The requirements for the latter requires board-certification (ACVIM or ECEIM) and a reasonable knowledge of spoken and written German.
