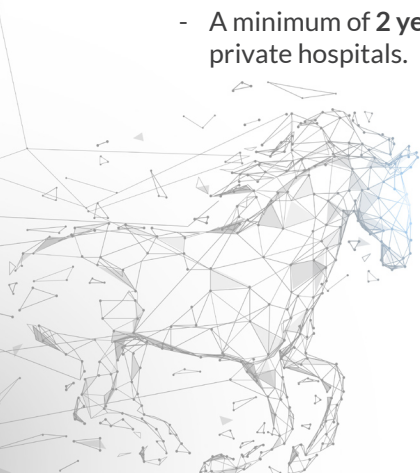

The newly-built hospital displays 2 operating theaters, an isolation unit, 3 spacious admission and examination rooms, an intensive care unit for adult horses and foals, a twin-room orthopedic suite with multiple exercising surfaces, a well-equipped farrier shop, and 50 hospitalization box stalls. The expected caseload should include a high volume of emergency cases and a large variety of horses presented for appointments, both providing fantastic clinical opportunities for our medical team.

Internal medicine, ICU, anesthesiology/pain management, surgery, orthopedics, dentistry, and sports medicine services will be provided in this newly-built state-of-the-art hospital. High quality digital X-Ray and ultrasonography, blood work as well as endoscopy services will be provided on site. Advanced imaging such as MRI, CT-scan (incl. open geometry robotic CT), and nuclear scintigraphy will be readily available in the other ECG hospitals.

The hospital will be staffed with an excellent multicultural and dynamic team of clinicians, residents and interns, veterinary assistants, and grooms.
