You are expected to integrate research into their practice of medicine where applicable.

#### **You will either be:**

- Board Certified by the American (Large Animal) or European (Equine) Colleges of Veterinary Internal Medicine; or
- a Fellow of the Australian and New Zealand College of Veterinary Scientists in an Equine Clinical discipline; or
- eligible to sit for certification or fellowship of the above and eligible for registration with the Veterinary Council of New Zealand.
