Clinical Residency Training Position

Equine Internal Medicine

The University Veterinary Teaching Hospital of the University of Sydney “Camden Equine Centre” is offering a clinical residency training position in Equine Internal Medicine. This program is approved under the European College of Equine Internal Medicine (ECEIM) and prepares the candidate to sit the examination and to become Diplomate of the college (recognized specialist in Equine Internal Medicine). Moreover, on successful completion of the three year training period, the candidate will graduate with two university degrees: a Master’s in Veterinary Studies (a Master’s coursework degree) and a Master’s degree in Veterinary Clinical Studies (a Master’s research degree) from the University of Sydney.

Camden Equine Centre is located in a semi-rural area approximately an hour from Sydney, close to the nice town Camden. Camden Equine Centre is an equine referral hospital that has multiple equine specialists in-house (American, European and Australian boarded specialists) allowing for a multi-modal approach of the patients. Currently there are 3 specialists in surgery, 1 in anesthesia, 1 in sports medicine, 2 in medicine, 1 in emergency and critical care and 1 consultant specialist in imaging.

The program starts in late July 2018, but earlier commencement can be considered. The program is of three years duration and is offered for full-time attendance only. The successful applicant is expected to contribute to the provision of clinical services of the entire equine teaching hospital, but will have a main focus on equine internal medicine. Active involvement in hospital rounds, journal club and research presentations are expected. Some supervision of undergraduate clinical trainees and contribution to after hours and weekend rosters are required.

Support for the program is in the form of a tax-free stipend of circa \$43,000 per annum and is only available to Australian citizens or Australian permanent residents.

Requirements are:

- Applicants must be an Australian citizen or have permanent residency status.
- Applicants must have a BVSc Honours degree, or equivalent.
- Applicants must have full registration (or be eligible for full registration) with the NSW Veterinary Practitioners Board.
- Applicants must have a minimum experience of a one year rotating internship or equivalent practice experience.
- Motivation

Demonstrated commitment to working in equine internal medicine and/or a publication(s) will be viewed favorably.
