Prerequisites for this position are an outstanding personality with excellent leadership skills and longstanding clinical experience in a discipline or subdiscipline of equine medicine, a university degree in veterinary medicine, a doctoral degree or a comparable specific qualification, teaching skills at university level, excellent academic achievements and a productive and promising research program. International board certification in a discipline of equine medicine is required. Several years of experience in raising third-party resources from national and international funding programs are desirable.

According to domestic legal guidelines (TAppV) the successful applicant will be responsible for teaching veterinary students.

As communication with students, staff, industry and stakeholder will require knowledge of spoken and written German, it is germane for the successful candidate to demonstrate the sincere willingness to become proficient in the German language.
