Professional Doctorate in Veterinary Medicine (Residency) in Equine Medicine

Applications are invited from veterinary graduates for a Professional Doctorate in Veterinary Medicine (Residency) in Equine Medicine. The scholarship will commence in March 2023 and will run for a four-year fixed-term, renewable annually subject to completion of required DVetMed components.

The position will be based at the Easter Bush Campus, Roslin, where the resident will participate in the activities of the Dick Vet Equine Hospital, specifically, the diagnosis and treatment of medical cases, as well as out of hours' emergencies. Relevant postgraduate clinical experience including at least a one-year rotating internship or at least two years clinical practice in equine/mixed practice is required, and candidates must be eligible to become a member of the RCVS. Applicants should also hold appropriate English language qualifications, where necessary.

The successful applicant will register for the European College of Equine Internal Medicine (ECEIM) Diploma in Equine Internal Medicine and a Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine (DVetMed) degree with clinical and teaching duties. The residency will be supervised by Prof Bruce McGorum.

The world-renowned Dick Vet Equine Hospital has a diverse group of staff with recognized specialists in medicine, surgery, dentistry, neurology, ophthalmology, anaesthesia and imaging, supported by a team of nurses and grooms. The Hospital also benefits from visiting farriers and physiotherapists and a behavioral consultant. Recent investment in the clinic has seen the opening of a state of the art equine diagnostic, surgical and critical care unit, and a high field MRI unit.

The residency attracts an annual tax-free stipend of £27,026.37 and an additional allowance of £1,500 per annum available for approved travel, examination fees and CPD. Postgraduate fees will be paid by the University of Edinburgh at UK level.
