

Residency in Equine Internal Medicine at Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences

The Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences (IKV), Faculty of Health and Medical Sciences, University of Copenhagen is offering a residency in Equine Internal Medicine from 1 January 2022 or as soon as possible thereafter for a period of four years.

Education and job content

In accordance with the requirements of the European College of Equine Internal Medicine the residency programme at the Department is structured as followed:

- Minimum programme length 3 years, preferable 4 years
- Strong emphasis on clinical duties with the majority of the programme spent participating in the clinical work at the Large Animal Teaching Hospital in Taastrup under direct supervision of the residency coordinator Charlotte Hopster-Iversen, Dipl. ECEIM
- The clinical work involves training and teaching of veterinary students
- The hospital is an ECEIM and ECVS training centre and the resident will work closely with board-certified specialists
- The resident work includes research and dissemination
- The resident will participate in the emergency service of the hospital including night and weekend on-calls

Qualifications

Following professional and personal qualifications are crucial for filling the position:

- Veterinary Master degree
- Danish Veterinary Authorization
- Eligibility to register as a resident with the European College of Equine Internal Medicine.
- Finished internship program of minimum 12 months duration or
- Comparable clinical experience
- Interest in clinical work in a university setting
- High degree of motivation, self-initiative and teamwork
- Ability to handle several tasks at the same time and experience in planning
- Independence in relation to the planning of work functions, research project, implementation of the program and associated examinations
- Experience within research, preferable with publications within the field of equine internal medicine
- Experience with and desire to teach veterinary students, preferred documented teaching experience at university level.
- Good skills within communication and cooperation
- Fluently in Danish and English, spoken and written

Terms of employment

The position is filled according to agreement between the Ministry of Finance and AC/Danish Veterinary Association. The position is full time, limited to 4 years in duration and employment ceases without further notice at the end of the fourth year. Supplements may be negotiated according to qualifications.
