

Internship Program

EMÜ Equine Hospital is an equine referral center located in Tartu, Estonia. The internship position is a 15-months clinical program open to veterinary graduates across the world. The objective of this internship is to provide an equine clinical experience through the following aims:

- *Develop clinical skills under the guidance of experienced specialists.
- *Foster development of interpersonal skills through communication with referring veterinarians, clients, and dedicated hospital team.
- *Stimulate curiosity-driven motivation.
- *Nurture academic professional development.
- *While the internship is an in-hospital internship, there might be opportunities for the interns to rotate into the field.

Applications for the 2023-2024 internship will be accepted from November 8th - December 9th 2022. The official start date of the internship is April 1st 2023. A possibility to start before can be discussed.

Applicants must submit the following for a complete application

- *Letter of Intent
- *Current CV
- *Reference letters from 3 veterinarians, preferably equine veterinarians

Visitation with in-person interview is encouraged and will be limited to the period December 1st - December 10th 2022. PLEASE NOTE: This policy may abruptly change based on potential COVID-19 protocols and/or restrictions. The successful applicant will be selected and notified by the end of December 2022 or January 2023.

Requirements for application

- *DVM or equivalent degree from a school of veterinary medicine
- *Demonstrated interest in equine medicine and surgery
- *Able to speak and write in English fluently
