

## **Position Title: Senior Clinician in Equine Internal Medicine. July 2022**

**We are looking for an ECEIM/ACVIM Diplomat (or board eligible candidate) to join our dynamic team in the Middle East. If you are looking to combine the highest standards of clinical work, research opportunities and an international adventure in a fast-moving, welcoming, and luxurious city then look no further!**

The Equine Veterinary Medical Center (EVMC) is a state-of-the-art equine referral center located within Al Shaqab, a magnificent horse complex situated in the heart of Education City, the educational hub of Qatar Foundation, in Doha, Qatar.

EVMC first opened its doors in 2018 and has since grown to see over 3000 cases per year and become one of the most advanced equine hospitals in the Middle East. The center is open for all horses in Qatar and the Gulf region. The hospital is equipped with a 3T MRI, CT-scan, nuclear scintigraphy, endoscopy and other modern imaging equipment including digital radiography and ultrasonography. The hospital has 3 operating theaters, an excellent purpose-built isolation unit, ICU for adult horses and foals, a well-equipped farrier shop, lameness examination areas on several surfaces and a well-equipped reproduction center. The medical services offered at EVMC include internal medicine/neonatal ICU, surgery, diagnostic imaging, sports medicine and rehabilitation, reproduction, anesthesiology and pain management. Our caseload includes a high volume of intensive emergency cases that provides fantastic clinical opportunities for our medicine team, which currently includes a permanent ECEIM resident.

EVMC also hosts a state-of-the-art veterinary diagnostic laboratory, including necropsy services. In 2021, the laboratory obtained the ISO/IEC 17025:2017 accreditation and today offers a wide range of diagnostic testing and pathogen identification. EVMC offers excellent research opportunities, and we encourage clinicians to establish independent and collaborative research projects, both national and international. Designated research laboratory space is available to assist, support and coordinate clinicians' research activities.

The hospital is staffed with an excellent multicultural and dynamic support team of veterinary residents and interns, qualified nurses, veterinary assistants, and grooms. This allows senior clinicians to practice the highest standard of veterinary medicine, pursue research interests and enjoy all the luxuries that Qatar has to offer.

**The successful candidate will be expected to:**

- Provide first class Equine Internal Medicine clinical services to EVMC patients, mainly in-house, including emergency and critical care, gastroenterology, neonatology, pneumology, neurology, ophthalmology, dermatology, and cardiology among others.
- Support the anesthesia/pain management service by supervising interns or residents conducting general anesthesia and neuroleptanalgesia for recumbent or standing surgical procedures respectively.
- Communicate efficiently and regularly with EVMC clients and referring veterinarians on the horses' medical conditions and update invoices.
- Contribute to the clinical training/teaching of residents, interns and externs, as well as EVMC's referring veterinarian community in the format of continuing educational opportunities.
- Perform emergency work after hours, during weekends and public holidays; to be shared with members of the medicine team.
- Provide administrative and strategic committee support occasionally.
- Contribute to the advancement of knowledge in equine veterinary medicine in your area of interest through retrospective and prospective research projects.
- Further the national, regional, and international reputation of EVMC.

**Qualifications and experience:**

- DVM or equivalent required.
- A completed residency in in Equine/Large Animal Internal Medicine.
- Ideally ACVIM or ECEIM Board certification. Fully eligible candidates will also be considered.
- A research degree (Masters or PhD) is highly desirable.
- Experience in Equine Internal Medicine, acquired at referral private hospitals or at university veterinary teaching hospitals.
- A publication record in veterinary medicine.
