Position title: Equine internist

MB Vet, a large equine clinic located in beautiful Normandy France is looking for a second equine internist for its hospital. The clinic is dedicated to equine patients, with 26 veterinarians both ambulatory and in house, shared between two sites. The clinic caters to elite thoroughbred and standardbred stud farms as well as warmblood and pleasure horses.

The facilities are brand new (2021) and feature an ICU and a NICU, isolations stall, 40 stalls, paddocks, numerous exam room, two operating room, a CT scan and our own in-house laboratory.

We are looking for a boarded or soon to be boarded ACVIM or ECEIM specialist.

The successful candidate will be expected to:

- Provide Equine Internal Medicine services to horses, mainly in-house, including emergency and critical care. There is a possibility, if interested, to also practice ambulatory medicine and sport medicine.
- Perform emergency work after hours, during weekends and public holidays; to be shared evenly with other internal medicine team members (one night a week and one week end out of four)
- Support the surgery service by supervising interns conducting general anesthesia and neuroleptanalgesia for recumbent or standing surgical procedures.
- Teach the interns and externs during their year of training.

Knowledge of French or willingness to learn and become rapidly fluent is mandatory. The position can be part time or full time and salary will be commensurate with experience. The position can be tailored to the applicant, so all inquiries are welcome !
