

Equine Internal Medicine Clinician; Rainbow Equine Hospital

Rainbow Equine Hospital, Malton, North Yorkshire, UK is seeking an internal medicine clinician for a 12 month maternity cover from December 2022. The job will entail a combination of clinical caseload, including night and weekend duty, and reporting for Rainbow Equine Lab.

Rainbow Equine Hospital is a large private equine clinic in the North of England and sees a mixture of sports, leisure and race horses. The hospital has a busy referral caseload covering all aspects of internal medicine, including gastrointestinal, respiratory, cardiac, neonatal, ophthalmology and sports medicine. There is a large multi-disciplinary team, including clinicians boarded in surgery, anaesthesia and imaging, as well as two ECEIM/ACVIM graduates. The hospital is fully equipped to provide an excellent level of diagnostic and therapeutic services, supported by an enthusiastic team of interns, nurses, yard staff and receptionists. Within the equine clinic there is an intensive care unit for adult horses and foals as well as separate isolation facilities.

Rainbow Equine Hospital prides itself on being a very friendly, approachable and collaborative team across all the disciplines and endeavours to support a good work/life balance.

Rainbow Equine Lab receives samples from equine practices across the UK as well as within the hospital. The lab is run separately by a highly qualified team of technicians, with reporting of results by the internal medicine clinicians. There is an emphasis on providing timely interpretation of results as well as advice and support for referring vets and practices submitting samples.

Malton is a market town on the edge of the North Yorkshire Moors and considered Yorkshire's Food Capital. There is easy access to York and from there onto London and Edinburgh, as well as to the North Yorkshire Moors and coastline.

Applicants should be eligible to work in the UK and either boarded (ACVIM/ECEIM) or eligible to sit boards.
