

Residency in EQUINE INTERNAL MEDICINE (ECEIM), Belgium

Bosdreef Equine hospital opens a new position for a resident in Equine Internal Medicine to start as soon as a suitable candidate is found.

Bosdreef is a state-of-the-art equine referral hospital providing expertise in all disciplines of equine medicine. We have in house ECVS, ECVDI and ECEIM diplomates. Residencies in equine surgery and large animal diagnostic imaging are enrolled as well.

The hospital is located in a new and modern building, fully equipped with video-endoscope, OTG endoscope, several ultrasound devices (Esaote), TMS, EMG, ECG, radiography, CT scan (Large Bore Canon Aquilion), sMRI (Hallmarq), gamma scintigraphy (MiE Medical), 2 surgical theaters, 2 recovery rooms, 14 ICU boxes and 40 regular care boxes. Description of the program:

- the program has a minimum length of 3 years, preferably 4 years
- the program in Equine Hospital Bosdreef has a strong emphasis on clinical duties, with the majority of the residency being spent participating in the clinical services. The resident will work primarily under the direct supervision of Katleen Vanschandevijl, Dipl. ECEIM.
- the resident will be working closely with interns, residents and board certified specialists.
- the residency also provides a vast clinical exposure to advanced diagnostic imaging, surgery, dentistry, orthopedic cases and sports horse medicine.
- the resident will be expected to complete a research project for publication
- the resident will be allowed to fulfill the externships in anesthesia, critical care, pathology, clinical pathology and diagnostic imaging as required by the ECEIM official program.
- the resident will take part in the emergency service of the hospital in a usually 1 out of 3 rota.

Prerequisites:

- the applicant must have a degree in Veterinary Medicine and must be authorized to practice veterinary medicine in a European Country.
- the applicant must have completed an EBVS-recognized internship program of minimum 12 months or have a similar experience of a minimum period of 24 months in equine medicine and surgery preferably in a referral setting
- Preference will be given to candidates with more extensive and/or autonomous working experience
- as we are an international team and the working language is English, the applicant must be fluid in English and be prepared to learn Dutch language within the first 6 months.

Applicants should send a CV and picture, with 3 listed references to Katleen Vanschandevijl (katleen.vanschandevijl@bosdreef.be) by December 31st 2020. We anticipate candidates will be invited for interview from January 4th. The evolution of the current COVID pandemic will dictate the practicalities of the interviews. After the interviews a selected group will be invited to spend a one week get-to-know-each-other externship at the hospital.
