Hunter Equine Centre have an exciting opportunity for an additional internal medicine specialist to join our team on a seasonal basis in Scone, the horse capital of Australia.

Our practice has an excellent, new facility at Scone racetrack with an intensive care unit including neonatal intensive care, isolation facility and general hospital facilities. The hospital currently provides an elective surgical facility with surgeons from our partner practice, Randwick Equine Centre, and a seasonal surgeon currently operating the facility, although we have council approval for a new surgical facility to be built this year. The hospital already provides a specialist internal medicine service with a boarded internal medicine specialist. The clinic is well equipped with multiple ultrasound, digital radiography, videoendoscopy and gastroendoscopy units as well as a comprehensive in-house laboratory.

We would like to fill this position with someone who is equally committed to providing the highest standard of care to our cliental. Experience in neonatal intensive care would be considered essential.

Selection criteria would require specialty registration and would also necessitate a Bachelor of Veterinary Science or equivalent that can be fully registered in New South Wales(www.vpb.gov.au). Hunter Equine Centre will assist with visa requirements to work in Australia.
