



Permanent position for Senior Clinician in Equine Internal Medicine (m/f/d)

- endoscopy (stationary and overground) and gastroscopy
- oral/dental endoscopy
- digital radiography (roof mounted and mobile system)
- in-house laboratory including cytospin, blood gas analysis, TBS/BAL, Lamp-Test
- roofed round pen for exercise test
- isolation unit

Our surgical theatres are fully equipped for arthroscopy, laparoscopy (recumbent and standing), basic fracture repair and soft tissue surgery including laser surgery.
